


- Wikis

  - Desktop shifts to Web (GMail, AJAX)
- Social Evolution
  - Collective creates additional value (Wiki, Tagging)
  - Free contents become popular (Licenses)



  - Text
  - Image
  - Audio
- \*reCaptcha



### reCaptcha



- Make use of Human Computing Power
- Take text from books that could not be deciphered with OCR.
- Repeat until enough users agree on the unknown text.
- This text is now known and book has been digitally encoded.

- ❖Formats: microdata, microformats, or RDFa.
- Started with its own vocabulary

- Meanwhile supports other popular vocabularies like foaf or vCard
- Still sort of experimental but with a high potential

- Currently only for review sites and social networking/people profile sites.


# Why Google and Wikipedia Are Not Enough!
