And now I'm more convinced we should do a clear search kind of thing as you initially proposed..

While looking at this I could trigger the view changing correctly when doing a repeated search, only this in effect would always show the last search when doing a fresh search. So if you searched for 2 different terms in succession with an `ESC` in between it would show the first search for a short while.

This is because we reuse the same list models and those are still filtered as per the prior search and only get re-filtered when the new search is finished.

So, actually my proposal now is to use an empty search term basically as a reset for the filtering, so when `GrTrackerWrapper` gets an empty search request, it sets the filters for the models to `Gtk.AnyFilter()` again. Music always does reset the search term when switching `NavigationStackPage`.

- Content should never be cut off abruptly with no divider at the end of a scrollview. I'd suggest using AdwToolbarView to get shadows for vertical scrolling, and make the content go all the way to the window edge horizontally.



- The window starts scrolling very early, both horizontally and vertically. It'd be good to avoid scrolling as much as possible, by having the content go all the way to the edge on the sides, reducing the size of the rest of the UI, and perhaps having a smaller breakpoint that scales down the grid at smaller window sizes.

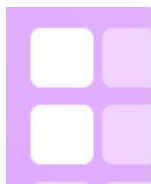

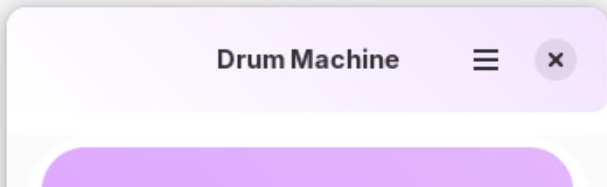

- ✓ The custom CSS is a bit heavy-handed and looks odd in places (e.g. the rounded headerbar, the huge buttons, the border on the toolbar). I'd tone it down a bit, and primarily use custom styles where they adds something over default styles (e.g. for the playback effect).
- ✓ The active grid squares are a bit low contrast in light mode. I'd suggest going with a lighter background and keeping them dark-on-light in light mode.



- ✓ Drop the dashes in some of the instrument names ( Kick-2 -> Kick 2 )
- ✓ The adaptive layout needs work, the toolbar should never scroll

Hey, great work on Drum Machine. I appreciate the simplicity as anything music related can rapidly spiral into feature creep. With a few changes, I can imagine two use cases:

1. To make a beat, while jamming along with a live instrument or a synth in another application.
2. To iterate on ideas, exporting loops for use later in a DAW.

The changes I think would best serve those use cases:

- Export to audio
- Option for longer pattern length. 32 steps is probably the minimum for making a loop that could be used in a musical context without feeling overly repetitive. 64 would be better.
- Swappable kit pieces to shape the sound - either with a fixed number of lanes with one lane for each instrument type, or adding the ability to add and remove an arbitrary number of instruments.
- Preset dropdown to swap all kit pieces at once. Typical selections like Rock, Funk, Pop, Techno.
- Time signature - a simple toggle between 3/4 and 4/4 would be enough I think.

I would like to contribute sounds especially, but wanted to check if a PR would fit into your plan and direction for the application.
